Ai Wei Wei: Circle of Animals/Zodiac Heads

The beautiful historic courtyard of London's Somerset House has never played host to contemporary art sculpture, but from May 12, it will showcase controversial Chinese artist Ai Wei Wei's Circle of Animals. The large bronze sculpture – comprising 12 heads representing the animals of the Chinese zodiac – is part of an international tour, which started in New York on May 2. Visit the New York version at the Pulitzer Fountain, Grand Army Plaza at Central Park until July 15.
